President-Elect 2024 POSITION STARTS <u>IMMEDIATELY</u> AFTER 2024 ELECTION RESULTS ARE VERIFIED TWO EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE POSITIONS STARTING IN 2025¹

DEADLINE: February 10, 2024

- → [Special Election] President-Elect 2024 (i.e., President 2025; Past-President 2026)--starts immediately after election results are verified and ends 31 Dec 2026.
- → **President-Elect 2025** (i.e., President 2026; Past-President 2027)--starts 1 Jan 2025 & ends 31 Dec 2027.
- → Member-at-Large --starts 1 Jan 2025 & ends 31 Dec 2027.

All positions are voting members of the D48 Executive Committee (EC)

Executive Committee (EC) members are expected to attend all meetings, including one to be held before, after, or during the annual APA convention, online meetings throughout the year, and possibly a winter or midyear meeting. A portion of travel expenses for the EC meeting(s) will be reimbursed according to the division's travel policy.

** Please nominate a colleague or yourself for these positions.**

President Elect becomes President in the 2nd year, and Past President in the 3rd year. In the 1st year, the President-elect prepares for their role as president in the upcoming year. The president elect is responsible for the general oversight of all ad hoc committees and groups and is a member of the Division Trio as well as of the Executive Committee. The president-elect will assist the president and will, if a situation where the president is unable to serve, assume the duties of the president. This is an Officer position; it cannot be filled by a Student Member.(*Please note that you must join or already be a member of Division 48 to be elected, but you do NOT have to be a member of the APA.*)

Member-at-Large will join the Executive Committee for three years. Members-at-large are elected on a staggered schedule so that at one time, there is one member-at-large in the 1st year of the term, one in the 2nd year of the term, and one in the 3rd year of the term. During the 2nd year of their term, the Member-at-Large will be in charge of the strategic planning process for the society. A student member may fill this position. (*Please note that you must join or already be a member of Division 48 to be elected, but you do NOT have to be a member of the APA*.)
